Reading through the list you will see the pattern of sincere men being sincerely wrong. I'm sure some are deceived, some are agents of Satan and others are merely out of their minds but they all have or had a following of sincere followers.

What benefit is there in looking back on these past, failed, prophecies? Doesn't this breed contempt and confusion for the Word of God and for Christians in general? Confusion, yes, and yes to making Christians look foolish and gullible but not from this study, or look at this type of deception. You, as a believer need, or should, welcome a critical look at what is going on under the name of Christianity. The degree of false prophets and prophecies are limited only by imagination. One thing is sure, as sure as the Word of God is Truth, and that is -- if you have to be told where YaHshshua is, then know this, you are being deceived, or an attempt is being made to deceive you. You see, your Bible tells you, in the recorded words of our Savior that you will not have to be told where He is or have any knowledge of when He is coming (Mathew 24:24-26).

These premature proclamations and their failures only serve to diminish the written Word's of God and keep mankind off balance, even distracted -- it is not the calling of attention, by a believer, that we are being laughed at but for accepting lies from self proclaimed prophets, some of whom claim the Creator God and our Savior is talking to them. These prophetic wanderings also demonstrate a certain population present in every generation ready to run for the fire exit at the first sign of a match being lit. We should not forget, our Savior told us things, things like war, and rumors of wars, and earthquakes in different places would come and go, but we are not to fret, *for the end is not yet. The date setters are disregarding the words of our Savior, YaHshua --*

*(Mat 25:13) Watch therefore, for ye know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of man cometh.*

We are told to "watch", watch what? If only the Father knows the day or the hour, then what are we watching for? The answer is in the prophetic statement made by YaHshua -- only the Father knows, not anyone else, not even YaHshua, therefore our "watching" is for the revealing that will be made by our Heavenly Father at the coming of YaHshua. Do you see? Men cannot tell you, your pastor, or a prophetic teacher, or a self-proclaimed prophet cannot tell you -- only the Father will make it known. So, if someone comes to you and tell you He is here, or there, or is going to be here or there then you know you are listening to a FALSE prophet, or teacher. Practice the *patience of the saints* and take comfort in the fact that all of the Children of the Living God, the saints, dead and alive will all know when YaHshua has returned to claim the Kingdoms as His. What we can know is the prophetic words of inspired Scripture, giving us clues as to how close we may be. Certainly every generation has thought, to one degree or another, that they were living in the end times, but the day is coming when there will be a generation of believers in those very days. They will see the Two Witnesses and the ultimate return of YaHshua. First, however, certain events have to happen, as the true word of God reports in advance some earth shaking (literally) events to occurred that have never happened before. These errors in prophetic observations also tend to diminish the truth, not only of the Word itself, but will eventually diminish the message of the two final witnesses, *true Biblical Prophets*, the *Two Witnesses* of Revelation 11 -- who will listen to them? Why should anyone take them seriously after this history of one wrong proclamation after another and all claiming the Holy bible as their source?

After some real earth shaking biblical events occur people will be so numbed to the doomsday prophets as to be sick of them. The Two Witnesses will be hated, not embraced, even despised for daring to proclaim natural disasters as the Wrath of God. These two Prophets of the Living God will not be setting dates, no, but they will be forecasting the weather, like it or not and their accuracy will be uncanny.

Setting dates is so wrong and misleading, as to be seen as a tool of Satan's in his efforts to shake things up and see what falls out. 2012, there may well be some terrible things happen, but then there are things happening every year. When the Creator God speaks, however, it may not be fully recognized as the Creator speaking. He can and will use His creation to literally shake mankind up, even to pieces. We need to be aware and as *good witnesses* be prepared to *witness* the awesome power of our Creator and Savior and pray that we might be able to stand in that day. That is, of course, if we are part of the generation living during the time of His and the Lamb's wrath (*Rev 6:12-17*)

### **More Comments from your humble servant:**

As you will notice in the 1993 sequence, the dating principle of a 1000 years equals a day. Peter uses it (2 Peter 3:8), and this seems to make sense. Some have set dates in the past based on the idea we are coming to the end of the 6000th year and entering the 7th day, the day of rest, or the Sabbath day of earth, if you will. Actually the 2000 AD debacle, is based loosely on this principle. Evangelical prophets began predicting 2000 AD as the year of complete melt down as the computer systems of the world collapse and somehow this all translated, from their minds, the kick off point for the "rapture". And this was not a bunch of "no-name" prophets, no, the list included nearly all of the those teachings the false "rapture" doctrine, names such as, Grant Jeffery, Hal Lindsay, Paul Crouch, and the, now infamous, Lalonde brothers (Peter and Paul) and many, many other modern prophets. You would have thought this would had put them all out of business, but it did not as the lay people still like to have their ears scratched and soothed with the escape doctrine (the rapture, then tribulation).

The Lalonde brothers were big movers and shakers in this popular genre of fear and escapism in a sudden [Rapture](#), or "snatching away" of the good Christians to "Heaven" while the bad Christians and the rest of the world must suffer the "tribulation". The brothers, Peter and Paul, have seemingly gone underground since their proclamations and their "Left Behind" tapes have proven to be so, so, wrong, but occasionally you see their names associated with film productions of fantasy events to occur during and after the "rapture". Paul Crouch, of the Trinity Broadcasting fame (TBN), is another force behind such worldly productions. It is truly amazing such talented men and such learned bible researchers would have so foolishly set their hopes on the 1000 years as a day rule, and applied it to the literal expression of years as seen in the modern calendar. They took 4000 years before our Savior's birth, then added the 2000 years after and came to 6000, making 2000 Ad the 6th day. The simple reasoning is not characteristic of most of the books they have written on the subject, but for some reason they tied this in with the supposed coming doom of computers not being able to operate past that years. This is truly a demonstration of the willingness of men to stop listening to the Word and to hear only themselves and their own desires.

By using the day as a 1000 years principle you would have thought someone would have consulted the Jewish scholars, after all, they are the 7th Day Sabbath keepers and the protectors of the written word, the Old Testament Canon, the book that give us the 7 day principle, wouldn't you? So, why don't we see what the Jewish scholars have to say, concerning the year we live in: According to the Jewish year, based on the history

of time, by their calculations of the times set by scripture and their traditions, we are not even close to the 6000th year, we are in the year, 5770, as of 2009 AD. -- that would mean we have at least 230 years before we start thinking about entering the 7th day, the day of SABBATH REST (Millennial rule of the Messiah). That's not much time, really, considering time as science sees it, even from a biblical point of view 230 years is short, still, I know of no one in the last 4500 years that has lived over 200 years, by that I mean, nearly all of the "rapture" teachers proclaim we are living in the "end days" now, that the Rapture is going to occur an "any moment". Their proclamations have failed in the past but they continue to ignore a vital key in understanding their way is not His way. They do not speak of the God of the Bible and they have little or no idea about whom our Savior really is.

I'm thinking, from all the pressure applied by rapture people (prophets), the general layperson may get a little tired of hearing, "any day now" as they grow older and older and begin dying off, as is already happening. Hum, we still have 2047 (see list above) for the termination of the human race at 3:28 AM -- now some of us might be around for that one -- that is, of course, if we live through 2012 -- Hey, the Mayans didn't.

I would like to make a correction to the statement above following the 2012 remark, "*this date is derived from the Mayan and the Aztec calendars*". This is not so, the Aztec calendar actually had a date but it has come and gone -- August 13, 1999, -- Yeah, I know, way past. Not sure how that one got by everyone but it did. I happen to have a very detailed book on the subject, Day Of Destiny, by John Mini, published in 1998. So, here is another proclamation of doom, from the Aztec, before the Mayan calendar, and it has been overlooked in the above list but you can fit it in as the *Aztec failure* of 1999. And we will see the eventual Mayan failure replaced by some other dating which will also be a failure. August 13, 1999, and that was on a Friday the 13th, too -- and dead wrong. We await December 21, 2012 knowing there are already other prophetic ramblings waiting in the wings to take center stage.

Another thing to consider is the question of why anyone should listen to the savage Indian, Mayans, or the Aztec, for that matter? Did they possess had greater wisdom than modern man? Where the Myans and the Aztec indians living in a knowledge explosion such as modern society? Do we really see evidence of this greater wisdom? Didn't they practice human sacrifice? Is that a mark of higher intelligence? Hasn't the world of the Aztec and the Mayan people vanished? Where are they now? If this knowledge is accurate what good did it do for them? What good will it do for us? Makes for an exciting movie, right? I think you get the idea. Certainly these prophetic claims based on Mayan intelligence seen through their pagan calendar cannot be true as their world came to an end many hundreds of years ahead of their precious calendar predictions. Rest assured, not even the demons of hell know the right time. Satan was cast to this earth over two thousand years ago and he has not been able to predict the second coming and the end of his rule. By spiritual time he knows his time is short and wouldn't he love to have the date, the exact time? He is in the dark but enjoys causing men to run to and fro after one prediction after another.

It can be fun to speculate, but turning one's speculations into fact is a whole different thing and we should take care not to over step our bounds. Some have become so self deluded as th write volumes all the while putting their necks on the chopping block as the dates they set come and go. Still, it is fascinating, not to set dates, but to see how close we may or may not be, and to see the truth of our savior's words as they unfold. It is great fun unraveling things hidden and being shown things unraveled that were hidden. We are the witnesses of the turth of His words as every generation moves through history. One day there will be an end, and the reality will no longer be speculation but will really be happening and this will strick terror in the hearts of mankind as sin filled earth shakes and is moved out of its place. Before Yahshua returns there is coming an event so huge as to make mankind think the world is literally coming to and end, and that mankind is going the way of the dinosaur, as modern men of [science teach](#) such things.
